The Public Outreach Committee will be responsible for creating and implementing an outreach plan for calendar year 2025. The committee will collaborate with the Area 9 Public Outreach Coordinator to determine District One's opportunities to support the Area 9 plan and respond to Public Service Announcements (PSAs) created by the WSO to attract new members to Al-Anon. These PSAs will soon be released on WCTV-Tallahassee, WANM 90.5 Florida A & M University, and FAMU-TV 20. Tentative ideas are:

- Dissemination of Alateen, Al-Anon meetings fliers and the new Meeting on Wheels flier
- Dissemination of *Al-Anon Faces Alcoholism* free magazine, with permission, at publicly available places, including library branches, health providers, stores, and other locations in Leon and surrounding counties.
- Providing/posting Al-Anon information at different libraries
- Outreach to Behavioral Health Programs such as Apalachee Behavioral Health, DISC Village, Capital Regional Medical Center, TMH to offer Meetings on Wheels
