Member Eligibility for Scholarship:

1. Live in District 1 and regularly attend District 1 Al-Anon meeting that has participated in fundraising activities for this event. "Regular attendance" will be self-determined in conjunction with person's Higher Power.
2. Buy at least one raffle ticket to win a scholarship for \$5.00 which will be on sale at participating group meetings from May 1 to date of the District One Wakulla Springs Family Picnic.
3. Drawing for the scholarship winner will be at Wakulla Springs Family Picnic (attendance at picnic is optional).
4. If a winner, willing to work with District 1 Treasurer to determine details of covering costs (such as need for up-front funds) and which receipts are necessary. Cost sharing with other members is encouraged, not required (such as travel to convention and rooming).

Group suggestions for participation:

1. After having a group conscience, include a dedicated envelope in group's basket for voluntary contributions to the Katy M. Scholarship. Submit scholarship contributions on a monthly basis to District 1 Treasurer, Adria C.
2. Provide a gift basket* to be raffled-off at a minimum of two of the following District 1 events: Gratitude lunch on February 8, District Workshop on April X, Wakulla Springs Family Picnic on June X
3. Offer scholarship raffle tickets for sale at meetings beginning in May.
